A non-renewable \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to one qualifying high school senior from each of the high schools located in Ellis County, Kansas and Morgan County, Colorado. ~~All applications must be submitted by March 31, 2020.~~ The application window has been extended, all applications must be submitted by April 30, 2020.

Qualifications:

- Recipient must be currently enrolled as a senior in a high school located in Ellis County, Kansas or Morgan County, Colorado.
- Recipient must plan to attend an accredited post-secondary school full-time in the fall of 2020.
- Recipient must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Recipient must be willing to attend a presentation at the local branch and be photographed with the other recipients.
- Recipient must supply a copy of their college schedule before scholarship funds are released. Checks will be made payable to the college they will be attending in the fall of 2020.
- Preference will be given to Golden Belt Bank customers.

- Include 1 letter of reference from a person outside of current academic setting.
- Include a high school transcript.
